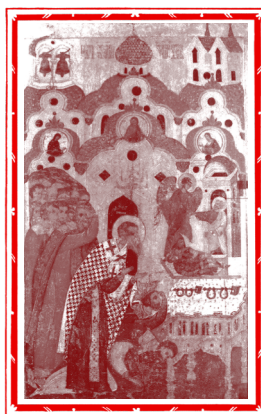

ST. PETER'S PRECIOUS CHAINS



Herod Agrippa, the grandson of Herod the Great and king of the Jews, grew wroth against the Church of Christ, and slew James, the brother of John the Evangelist. Seeing that this pleased the Jews, he took Peter also into custody and locked him up in prison, intending to keep him there until after the feast of the Passover, so that he could win the favour of the people by presenting him to them as a victim. But the Apostle was saved when he was miraculously set free by an Angel (Acts 12:1-19). The chains wherewith the Apostle was bound received from his

most sacred body the grace of sanctification and healing, which is bestowed upon the faithful who draw nigh with faith.

That such sacred treasures work wonders and many healings is witnessed by the divine Scripture, where it speaks concerning Paul, saying that the Christians in Ephesus had such reverence for him, that his handkerchiefs and aprons, taken up with much reverence, healed the sick of their maladies: "So that from his body were brought unto the sick handkerchiefs or aprons, and the diseases departed from them, and the evil spirits went out of them" (Acts 19:12). But not only the Apostles' clothing (which certainly touched the bodies of the sick), but even their shadow alone performed healings. On beholding this, people put their sick on stretchers and beds and brought them out into the streets that, when Peter passed by, his shadow "might overshadow some of them"(Acts 5:15). From this the Orthodox Catholic Church has learned to show reverence and piety not only to the relics of their bodies, but also in the clothing of God's Saints.

Resurrectional Apolytikion

Plagal 1st Mode

Let us worship the Word who is unoriginate with the Father and the Spirit, and from a Virgin was born for our salvation, O believers, and let us sing His praise. For in His goodness He was pleased to ascend the Cross in the flesh, and to undergo death, and to raise up those who had died, by His glorious Resurrection.

Apolytikion for the Apostle

4th Mode

Without leaving Rome, you came to us, through the precious Chains that you wore, O President of the Apostles. As we venerate them in faith, we pray to you: By your intercessions with God, grant to us the great mercy.

Apolytikion of Pentecost

Plagal 4th Mode

Blessed are You, O Christ our God, who made fishermen all-wise, sending upon them the Holy Spirit and, through them, netting the world. O Loving One, glory to You.

Apolytikion of the Prophet Elias

4th Mode

The incarnate Angel, the Cornerstone of the Prophets, the second Forerunner of the Coming of Christ, the glorious Elias, who from above, sent down to Elisha the grace to dispel sickness and cleanse lepers, abounds therefore in healing for those who honor him.

Kontakion

1st Mode

You sanctified the virginal womb by Your birth, O Lord, and blessed the hands of Symeon fittingly, O Christ God; and even now You came and saved us. Now, give peace to our Nation in time of war, and empower our Leaders, so loved by You, the only one who loves humanity.

THE EPISTLE



Prokeimenon: You shall guard us, O Lord; You shall preserve us.

Verse: Save me, O Lord, for the holy man has ceased.

The reading is from Paul's Letter to the Colossians.

(3:4-11)

Brethren, when Christ who is our life appears, then you also will appear with him in glory. Put to death therefore what is earthly in you: fornication, impurity, passion, evil desire, and covetousness, which is idolatry. On account of these the wrath of God is coming upon the sons of disobedience. In these you once walked, when you lived in them. But now put them all away; anger, wrath, malice, slander, and foul talk from your mouth. Do not lie to one another, seeing that you have put off the old nature with its practices and have put on the new nature, which is being renewed in knowledge after the image of its creator. Here there cannot be Greek and Jew, circumcised and uncircumcised, barbarian, Scythian, slave, free man, but Christ is all, and in all.

THE GOSPEL

The reading is from the Holy Gospel according to Luke.

(17:12-19)

At that time, as Jesus entered a village, He was met by ten lepers, who stood at a distance and lifted up their voices and said: "Jesus, Master, have mercy on us." When He saw them He said to them, "Go and show yourselves to the priests." And as they went they were cleansed. Then one of them, when he saw that he was healed, turned back, praising God with a loud voice; and he fell on his face at Jesus's feet, giving Him thanks. Now he was a Samaritan. Then said Jesus: "Were not ten cleansed? Where are the nine? Was no one found to return and give praise to God except this foreigner?" And He said to him: "Rise and go your way; your faith has made you well."





PARISH COUNCIL UPDATE



The 2022 Parish Council held its first meeting on Monday, January 10. Already, the Council is addressing the needs of the community head-on and want to start by making sure that their activity in fulfilling their role is communicated to the Parish regularly. From now on, there will be an update here in the bulletin once a month, so that the whole parish can stay up to date on their discussions and the measures they take to manage the business of the community.

In this meeting, the Parish Council discussed the following items:

- 1) A lively discussion was had about parish finances, especially stewardship. As we approach the potential of losing or relocating our Greek Festival while the Cornerstone Project is built, we have taken notice that our stewardship falls far short of sustaining the ministry of the parish. This is quite concerning, and it will be a point of focus for this Parish Council to address and correct.
- 2) A structural engineering firm has been contracted, Reaveley Engineers and Associates, in pursuit of correcting the structural damage done to Holy Trinity Cathedral in the earthquake of 2020. This project is being undertaken with the help of FEMA, and will bring the entire building up to seismic code when completed.
- 3) With the closure of the LaFrance apartments, approved by the last Parish Assembly, we now have a problem with those vacant buildings attracting a large homeless population. This in turn has involved the Salt Lake Police Department almost daily. The Parish Council is investigating hiring private security to address this situation.
- 4) The Parish Council decided to close Holy Trinity on February 6, so that the whole parish can gather together at Prophet Elias, under its glorious new dome iconography!
