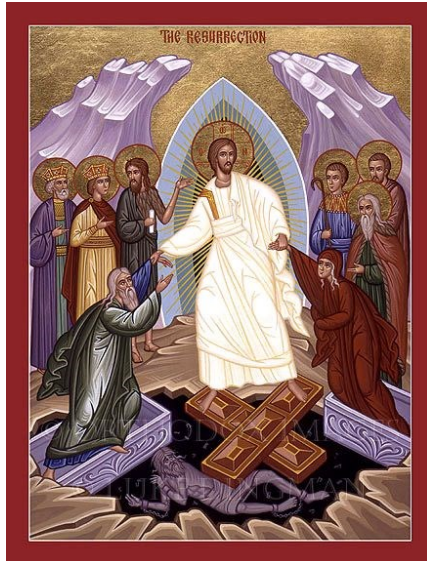

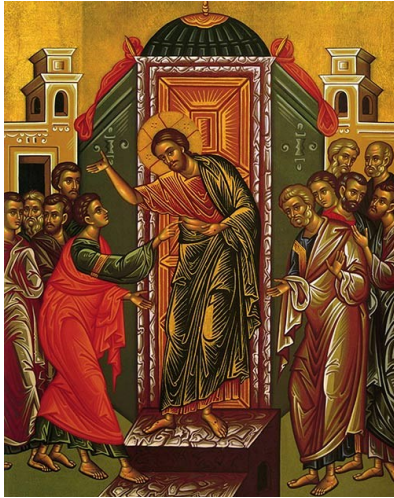

THOMAS SUNDAY



Though the doors were shut at the dwelling where the disciples were gathered for fear of the Jews on the evening of the Sunday after the Passover, our Saviour wondrously entered and stood in their midst, and greeted them with His customary words, "Peace be unto you." Then He showed unto them His hands and feet and side; furthermore, in their presence, He took some fish and a honeycomb and ate before them, and thus assured them of His bodily

Resurrection. But Thomas, who was not then present with the others, did not believe their testimony concerning Christ's Resurrection, but said in a decisive manner, "Except I shall see in His hands the print of the nails, and put my finger into the print of the nails, and thrust my hand into His side, I will not believe." Wherefore after eight days, that is, on this day, when the disciples were again gathered together and Thomas was with them, the Lord Jesus came while the doors were shut, as He did formerly. Standing in their midst, He said, "Peace be unto you"; then He said to Thomas, "Bring hither thy finger, and behold my hands; and bring hither thy hand, and thrust it into My side: and be not unbelieving, but believing."

And Thomas, beholding and examining carefully the hands and side of the Master, cried out with faith, "My Lord and my God." Thus he clearly proclaimed the two natures - human and divine - of the God-man (Luke 24:36-49; John 20:19-29).

This day is called Antipascha (meaning "in the stead of Pascha," not "in opposition to Pascha") because with this day, the first Sunday after Pascha, the Church consecrates every Sunday of the year to the commemoration of Pascha, that is, the Resurrection.

THE EPISTLE



Prokeimenon:

The reading is from the Acts of the Apostles

(5:12~20)

In those days, many signs and wonders were done among the people by the hands of the apostles. And they were all together in Solomon's Portico. None of the rest dared join them, but the people held them in high honor. And more than ever believers were added to the Lord, multitudes both of men and women, so that they even carried out the sick into the streets, and laid them on beds and pallets, that as Peter came by at least his shadow might fall on some of them. The people also gathered from the towns around Jerusalem, bringing the sick and those afflicted with unclean spirits, and they were all healed. But the high priest rose up and all who were with him, that is, the party of the Sadducees, and filled with jealousy they arrested the apostles and put them in the common prison. But at night an angel of the Lord opened the prison doors and brought them out and said, "Go and stand in the temple and speak to the people all the words of this Life."

THE GOSPEL



The reading is from the holy Gospel according to John
(20:19–31)

On the evening of that day, the first day of the week, the doors being shut where the disciples were for fear of the Jews, Jesus came and stood among them and said to them: “Peace be with you.” When He had said this, He showed them His hands and His side. Then the disciples were glad when they saw the Lord. Jesus said to them again, “Peace be with you. As the Father has sent me, even so I send you.” And when He had said this, He breathed on them, and said to them: “Receive the Holy Spirit. If you forgive the sins of any, they are forgiven; if you retain the sins of any, they are retained.” Now Thomas, one of the twelve, called the Twin, was not with them when Jesus came. So the other disciples told him: “We have seen the Lord.” But he said to them: “Unless I see in His hands the print of the nails, and place my finger in the mark of the nails, and place my hand in His side, I will not believe.” Eight days later, His disciples were again in the house, and Thomas was with them. The doors were shut, but Jesus came and stood among them, and said: “Peace be with you.” Then He said to Thomas, “Put your finger here, and see my hands; and put out your hand, and place it in my side; do not be faithless, but believing.” Thomas answered Him, “My Lord and my God!” Jesus said to Him: “Have you believed because you have seen me? Blessed are those who have not seen and yet believe.” Now Jesus did many other signs in the presence of the disciples, which are not written in this book; but these are written that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that believing you may have life in His name.

- Salt Lake City's Greektown -

Of all the Greek Towns in Utah during the first half of the 20th Century, Salt Lake City's was the largest and most vibrant, housing 100 Greek-owned businesses and 5,000 Greeks who lived, worked and socialized near the railyards and church.

- **Greek run** candy stores, bars, barber shops, grocery stores, drug stores, restaurants, theaters and coffee houses operated primarily in the area of 200 South between 400 and 600 West.
- **Gust Papadopoulos** with son, **John**, owned Corinthos Grocery and Meat Co.; **Chris Vigos** and **Harry Kopan** operated the National Café on Rio Grande Street; **Peter Sefakis** ran the Mecca Coffee and Cash Grocery; **Kalivas Grocery** was at 454 West 200 South, and **Michael Katsanevas** ran the Open Heart Coffee House at 540 West 200 South, to name just a few.
- **The Great Depression** (1929-1936) caused many Greek shops to close and Greek laborers became unemployed.
- **Church membership** dwindled to 50 -- in good standing -- and annual dues were reduced to \$6 per family per year.
- **Dedicated clergy** and church board members implemented several progressive changes in the administration of the church to help keep it functioning.
- **By 1960** Salt Lake City's Greek Town had ceased to exist as many businesses had opened in other parts of the city and the Greek community had become integrated into mainstream America.

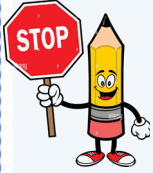
