RELICS OF UNMERCENARIES CYRIL & JOHN



These Saints lived during the years of Diocletian. Saint Cyril was from Alexandria, and Saint John was from Edessa of Mesopotamia. Because of the persecution of that time, Cyril fled to the Gulf of Arabia, where there was a small community of monks. John, who was a soldier, heard of Cyril's fame and came to join him. Henceforth, they passed their life working every virtue, and healing every illness and disease freely by the grace of Christ; hence their title of "Unmercenaries." They heard that a certain woman, named Athanasia, had been apprehended together with her three daughters, Theodora, Theoctiste, and Eudoxia, and taken to the tribunal for their confession of the Faith. Fearing lest the tender young maidens be terrified by the torments and renounce Christ, they went to strengthen them in their contest in martyrdom; therefore they too were seized. After Cyril and John and those sacred women had been greatly tormented, all were beheaded in the year 292. Their tomb became a renowned shrine in Egypt, and a place of universal pilgrimage. It was found in the area of the modern day resort near Alexandria named Abu Kyr.

Apolytikion of Pentecost (for the Holy Trinity)

Blessed are You, O Christ our God, who made fishermen all-wise, sending upon them the Holy Spirit and, through them, netting the world. O Loving One, glory to You.

Apolytikion of the Prophet Elias

The incarnate Angel, the Cornerstone of the Prophets, the second Forerunner of the Coming of Christ, the glorious Elias (Elijah), who from above, sent down to Elisha the grace to dispel sickness and cleanse lepers, abounds therefore in healing for those who honor him.

THE EPISTLE



Prokeimenon:

The Lord is my strength and my song,
and He became my salvation.


Verse:

*The Lord chastened and corrected me,
but He did not give me up to death.*

The reading is from Paul's Letter to the Romans.

(5:1-10)

Brethren, since we are justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ. Through him we have obtained access to this grace in which we stand, and we rejoice in our hope of sharing the glory of God. More than that, we rejoice in our sufferings, knowing that suffering produces endurance, and endurance produces character, and character produces hope, and hope does not disappoint us, because God's love has been poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit which has been given to us. While we were still weak, at the right time Christ died for the ungodly. Why, one will hardly die for a righteous man—though perhaps for a good man one will dare even to die. But God shows his love for us in that while we were yet sinners Christ died for us. Since, therefore, we are now justified by his blood, much more shall we be saved by him from the wrath of God. For if while we were enemies we were reconciled to God by the death of his Son, much more, now that we are reconciled, shall we be saved by his life.

THE GOSPEL



The reading is from the holy Gospel according to Matthew

(6:22~33)

The Lord said, "The eye is the lamp of the body. So, if your eye is sound, your whole body will be full of light; but if your eye is not sound, your whole body will be full of darkness. If then the light in you is darkness, how great is the darkness! No one can serve two masters; for either he will hate the one and love the other, or he will be devoted to the one and despise the other. You cannot serve God and mammon. Therefore I tell you, do not be anxious about your life, what you shall eat or what you shall drink, nor about your body, what you shall put on. Is not life more than food, and the body more than clothing? Look at the birds of the air: they neither sow nor reap nor gather into barns, and yet your heavenly Father feeds them. Are you not of more value than they? And which of you by being anxious can add one cubit to his span of life? And why are you anxious about clothing? Consider the lilies of the field, how they grow; they neither toil nor spin; yet I tell you, even Solomon in all his glory was not arrayed like one of these. But if God so clothes the grass of the field, which today is alive and tomorrow is thrown into the oven, will he not much more clothe you, O men of little faith? Therefore do not be anxious, saying, 'What shall we eat?' or 'What shall we drink?' or 'What shall we wear?' For the Gentiles seek all these things; and your heavenly Father knows you need them all. But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things shall be yours as well."

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS TO VOTE/PARTICIPATE

AT PARISH ASSEMBLIES AS DETERMINED BY THE UPR AND

THE PARISH COUNCIL DECISIONS

- You must be a parishioner in good standing/current steward. To be considered a current steward you must have paid stewardship for the current year. If you are a new steward to the parish, you must have paid stewardship at least 3 months prior to the date of the Parish Assembly.
- If you are 1-2 years in arrears, you must pay your past stewardship due for the years missed and for the current year. (For example, if you paid stewardship in 2021 but not in 2022 or 2023, you would need to pay stewardship for 2023, but also for 2022 that you missed based on the average amount that you had paid in 2021 and prior years by the day of the Parish Assembly.)
- If you have not been a steward for more than 2 years, then you are considered to be a NEW steward of the parish and would fall under the 3-month rule. (For example, if the last time you paid stewardship was in 2020 or before, then you would need to pay stewardship at least 3 months prior to the Parish Assembly.)
- If you are a current steward to date but normally pay your stewardship towards the end of the year, then we ask that you please pay a portion of your stewardship by the date or on the date of the Parish Assembly.
- If you are not sure of your stewardship standing, please call the Church Office for clarification.

The Parish Council intends to have a **Special Assembly on Sunday, September 24, 2023, to vote on the Woodbury Downtown Project**. Thus, if the last time you paid stewardship was in 2020 or before, you would need to become a steward no later than 3 months prior to September 24th, which would be **NO LATER THAN FRIDAY, JUNE 23RD**, in order to participate and vote at this Special Assembly.
