# HOLY FATHERS OF THE 4TH ECUMENICAL COUNCIL



On the Sunday that falls from the 13th to the 19th of the present month, we chant the Service to the 630 Holy and God-bearing Fathers who came together for the 4th Ecumenical Council who assembled in Chalcedon in 451, to condemn Eutyches, who taught that there was only one nature, the divine, in Christ after the Incarnation, and Dioscorus, Patriarch of Alexandria, who illegally received Eutyches back into communion and deposed Saint Flavian, Patriarch of Constantinople, who had excommunicated Eutyches.

In the Slavic tradition, on this Sunday, the Fathers of the first six Ecumenical Councils are all commemorated.

## For the Fathers

Supremely blessed are You, O Christ our God. You established the holy Fathers upon the earth as beacons, and through them You have guided us all to the true Faith, O greatly merciful One, glory be to You.

## For the Holy Woman

Your maiden Martyr, like a lamb, cries out, "O Jesus, for You, my pure Bridegroom, I long; and seeking You I compete; and I am crucified and buried with You in Your baptism. I suffer for Your sake, that I may reign with You. I die for You that I may also live in You. Accept me as an unblemished sacrifice as I offer myself to You with love." At her entreaties and intercessions, save our souls, O Merciful Lord

## Apolytikion of Pentecost (for the Holy Trinity)


Blessed are You, O Christ our God, who made fishermen all-wise, sending upon them the Holy Spirit and, through them, netting the world. O Loving One, glory to You.

## Apolytikion of the Prophet Elias

The incarnate Angel, the Cornerstone of the Prophets, the second Forerunner of the Coming of Christ, the glorious Elias (Elijah), who from above, sent down to Elisha the grace to dispel sickness and cleanse lepers, abounds therefore in healing for those who honor him

But avoid stupid controversies, genealogies, dissensions, and quarrels over the law, for they are unprofitable and futile. As for a man who is factious, after admonishing him once or twice, have nothing more to do with him, knowing that such a person is perverted and sinful; he is self-condemned. When I send Artemas or Tychicos to you, do your best to come to me at Nicopolis, for I have decided to spend the winter there. Do your best to speed Zenas the lawyer and Apollos on their way; see that they lack nothing. And let our people learn to apply themselves to good deeds, so as to help cases of urgent need, and not to be unfruitful. All who are with me send greeting to you. Greet those who love us in the faith. Grace be with you all. Amen.

Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father who is in heaven. Think not that I have come to abolish the law and the prophets; I have come not to abolish them but to fulfill them. For truly, I say to you, till heaven and earth pass away, not an iota, not a dot, will pass from the law until all is accomplished. Whoever then relaxes one of the least of these commandments and teaches men so, shall be called least in the kingdom of heaven; but he who does them and teaches them shall be called great in the kingdom of heaven."

# THE CONFESSION OF CHALCEDON



The Confession of Chalcedon, the formal statement of faith agreed upon by the Fathers of the 4<sup>th</sup> Ecumenical Council, provides a clear statement on the two natures of Christ, human and divine:

We, then, following the holy Fathers, all with one consent, teach people to confess one and the same Son, our Lord Jesus Christ, the same perfect in Godhead and also perfect in manhood; truly God and truly man, of a reasonable [rational] soul and body; consubstantial [co-essential] with the Father according to the Godhead, and consubstantial with us according to the Manhood; in all things like unto us, without sin; begotten before all ages of the Father according to the Godhead, and in these latter days, for us and for our salvation, born of the Virgin Mary, the Mother of God, according to the Manhood; one and the same Christ, Son, Lord, only begotten, to be acknowledged in two natures, inconfusedly, unchangeably, indivisibly, inseparably; (έν δύο φύσεσιν άσυγγύτως, άτρέπτως, άδιαιρέτως, άχωρίστως) the distinction of natures being by no means taken away by the union, but rather the property of each nature being preserved, and concurring in one Person (prosopon) and one Subsistence (hypostasis), not parted or divided into two persons, but one and the same Son, and only begotten God (μονογενή Θεόν), the Word, the Lord Jesus Christ; as the prophets from the beginning [have declared] concerning Him, and the Lord Jesus Christ Himself has taught us, and the Creed of the holy Fathers has handed down to us.

# REAL ESTATE COMMITTEE



The Real Estate Committee is happy to report that we are making significant progress toward reaching an agreement to move forward on our legacy downtown project.

Members of our committee have met with Woodbury multiple times in the past three weeks. They have substantial momentum in preparing a proposal for our community to review in the coming months.

There will be many details, but here are some significant areas of advancement:

- Both partners have identified their legal counsel and those lawyers have begun drafting up the structural documents necessary to finalize an arrangement.
- It is likely that we will be able to receive the shell of our community center at no debt to the community. This will allow us to use our raised funds to finish off the community center.
- There will be no parking costs for our community.
- It is likely that our minimum base rent could be above \$1 million annually
- There will be a negotiated upside revenue sharing above base rent.
- It is possible that we will move both the community center and the Crane property to the initial phase of the timeline.
- There is continued negotiation on many issues including:
  - Woodbury's role in the development of the plaza and around the Cathedral
  - Compensation for the demolition of the LaFrance apartments.
  - Timeline on the income payments to our community during construction
  - Lost festival space and income during construction
  - Timeline and deadline for rezoning requests
  - Condominium options
  - Property management considerations
  - Reserve funding for future improvements

The Real Estate Committee will be meeting with the Parish Council on a regular basis to report on the details of the progress made in negotiations. There will also be periodic updates to the community via the Bulletin, Flocknote, and email.

We will also be holding another series of community forums in order to get updated input from our members on the details of our project.

Thank you all for your support of our parish and we look forward to an exciting few months ahead.
