St. John's First Universal letter 1:1-7

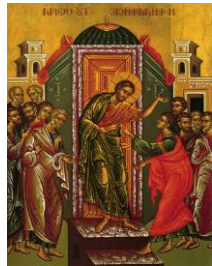


THAT WHICH WAS from the beginning, which we have heard, which we have seen with our eyes, which we have looked upon and touched with our hands, concerning the word of life - the life was made manifest, and we saw it, and testify to it, and proclaim to you the eternal life which was with the Father and was made manifest to us - that which we have seen and heard we proclaim also to you, so that you may have fellowship with us; and our fellowship is with the Father and with his Son Jesus Christ. And we are writing this that our joy may be complete. This is the message we have heard from him and proclaim to you, that God is light and in him is no darkness at all. If we say we have fellowship with him while we walk in

darkness, we lie and do not live according to the truth; but if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus his Son cleanses us from all sin.

Gospel Reading

The Gospel of John 20:19-31



On the evening of that day, the first day of the week, the doors being shut where the disciples were for fear of the Jews, Jesus came and stood among them and said to them: "Peace be with you." When He had said this, He showed them His hands and His side. Then the disciples were glad when they saw the Lord. Jesus said to them again, "Peace be with you. As the Father has sent me, even so I send you." And when He had said this, He breathed on them, and said to them: "Receive the Holy Spirit. If you forgive the sins of any, they are forgiven; if you retain the sins of any, they are retained."

Now Thomas, one of the twelve, called the Twin, was not with them when Jesus came. So the other disciples told him: "We have seen the Lord." But he said to them: "Unless I see in His hands the print of the nails, and place my finger in the mark of the nails, and place my hand in His side, I will not believe."

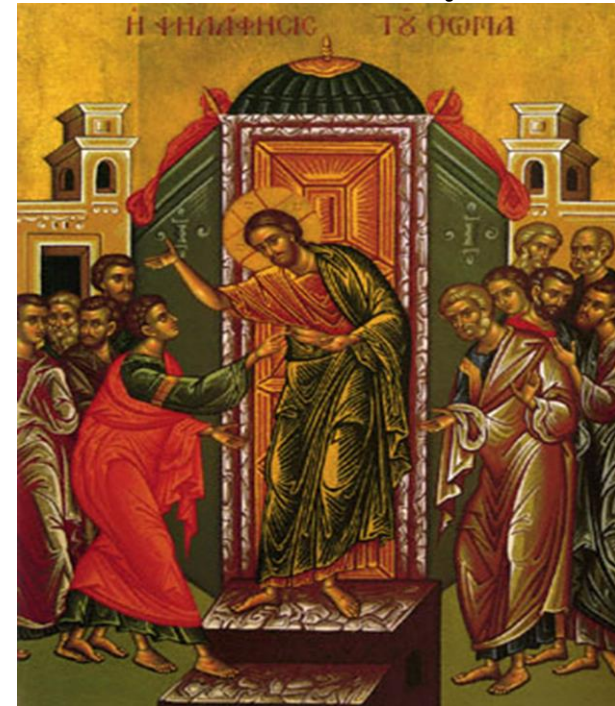
Eight days later, His disciples were again in the house, and Thomas was with them. The doors were shut, but Jesus came and stood among them, and said: "Peace be with you." Then He said to Thomas, "Put your finger here, and see my hands; and put out your hand, and place it in my side; do not be faithless, but believing." Thomas answered Him, "My Lord and my God!" Jesus said to Him: "Have you believed because you have seen me? Blessed are those who have not seen and yet believe."

Now Jesus did many other signs in the presence of the disciples, which are not written in this book; but these are written that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that believing you may have life in His name.

IMPORTANT MESSAGES FROM FATHER MATTHEW

CHRIST IS RISEN!

Having completed the period of the Triodion (and the book which bears its name), we have now entered into the period of the Pentecostarion, which began with the vigil of Pascha and will conclude on the Sunday of All Saints (a period of eight weeks). Like the Triodion, the Pentecostarion also gave its name to the liturgical book used during this period.

We cannot possibly understand and absorb the meaning and mystery of the Resurrection in one night, and so the Church represents us with an eight-week period, a time when we walk with the Risen Christ during this forty-day sojourn on earth, followed by His Ascension and the descent of the Holy Spirit.

During the Paschal season, let us greet one another with the triumphant and joyful greeting of "Christ is Risen", which proclaims our very faith as Orthodox Christians. This greeting is commonly used until the celebration of our Lord's Ascension into heaven, forty days after Christ's Resurrection. Yet, even after these forty days have passed, may we continue to celebrate the Lord's Resurrection with the same fervor, each and every Sunday!

SPECIAL ANOINTING TODAY AND NEXT WEEK

You may have heard that an icon of **SAINT JOHN THE BAPTIST** at **Assumption Greek Orthodox Church** in a **Chicago** suburb has been **exuding oil** since last July 19. This is truly extraordinary, especially when we consider that Saint John always preached the message of repentance! When Presbyteria Denise venerated this beautiful icon several weeks ago, she was given oil that was exuding from the icon. Thus, I rejoice in this blessing to **ANOINT** those who will be at **Holy Trinity** this **Sunday, May 8**; I will also anoint those who will be at **Prophet Elias** on **Sunday, May 15**. This will take place immediately following Divine Liturgy. Let us come forward with repentance in our hearts to receive this oil that Saint John the Baptist has gifted us!

THE GREATEST OF ALL MOTHERS

The Most Holy Theotokos loves us greatly and desires our salvation. She intercedes for our salvation with heartfelt sighs. This is something we should never forget. How should we react to this great love of the Mother of God for us? It is certainly impossible for us not to love her in return. And how can we express our love for the Mother of God? By struggling for that which she desires more than anything else. And what is it that she desires more than anything else? -- Our salvation. Just as her Son does, so does she desire that "all should be saved and come to the knowledge of the truth". Let us make our way of life a cause of joy to the Mother of God. Let us struggle to ever increase in all good, in purity, humility, in love – things in which the Mother of God abounded.

Today as we remember our wonderful mothers with heartfelt thanksgiving and love, we offer to all mothers the following spiritual counsel on raising children: "Prayer is trusting in God. When your trust is completely in God, it is not even necessary to pray for something, for God takes over. It's just that one ought to wait with patience for the fruit to ripen and fall off the tree. Therefore, mothers, trust your children to God; for you have given them only your flesh, but God has created their souls. So He is obliged to take care of them."

Stewardship Minimum and Eligibility For Voting at the Spring Parish Assembly May 15, 2016

At the Fall 2014 Parish Assembly a motion was passed for an annual minimum amount of **\$600/family** and **\$300/individual** and for those with extenuating circumstances, they should consult with the clergy.

Individuals: (\$300 Minimum)

- Anyone 18 years of age or older, including students

Family: (\$600 Minimum)

- Couples, with or without a minor child or children
- An parent/individual with a minor child or children

In order to vote in the upcoming Parish Assembly you must have met last year's commitment (2015) and have made a pledge for 2016.

Further, a member in good standing in the Orthodox Church means one must be *baptized and/or chrismated in the Orthodox Church; and if civilly divorced, one must have an Ecclesiastical (Church) Divorce.*
