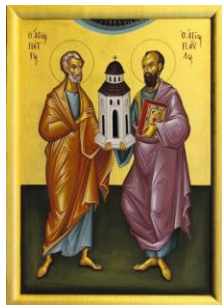


## Epistle Reading

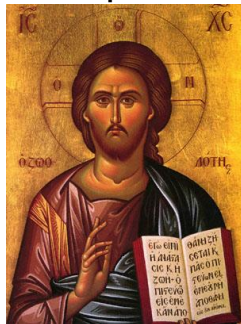
### St. Paul's Letter to the Romans 10:1-10



BRETHREN, my heart's desire and prayer to God for them is that they may be saved. I bear them witness that they have a zeal for God, but it is not enlightened. For, being ignorant of the righteousness that comes from God, and seeking to establish their own, they did not submit to God's righteousness. For Christ is the end of the law, that everyone who has faith may be justified. Moses writes that the man who practices the righteousness that is based on the law shall live by it. But the righteousness based on faith says, do not say in your heart, "Who will ascend into heaven?" (That is, to bring Christ down) or "Who will descend into the abyss?" (That is, to bring Christ up from the dead). But what does it say? The word is near you, on your lips and in your heart (that is, the word of faith, which we preach); because, if you confess with your lips that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. For man believes with his heart and so is justified, and he confesses with his lips and so is saved.

### The Gospel According to Matthew 5:14-19



At that time, when Jesus came to the other side, to the country of the Gergesenes, two demoniacs met him, coming out of the tombs, so fierce that no one would pass that way. And behold, they cried out, "What have you to do with us, O Son of God? Have you come here to torment us before the time?" Now a herd of many swine was feeding at some distance from them. And the demons begged him, "If you cast us out, send us away into the herd of swine." And he said to them, "Go." So they came out and went into the

swine; and behold, the whole herd rushed down the steep bank into the sea, and perished in the waters. The herdsmen fled, and going into the city they told everything, and what had happened to the demoniacs. And behold, all the city came out to meet Jesus; and when they saw him, they begged him to leave their neighborhood. And getting into a boat he crossed over and came to his own city.

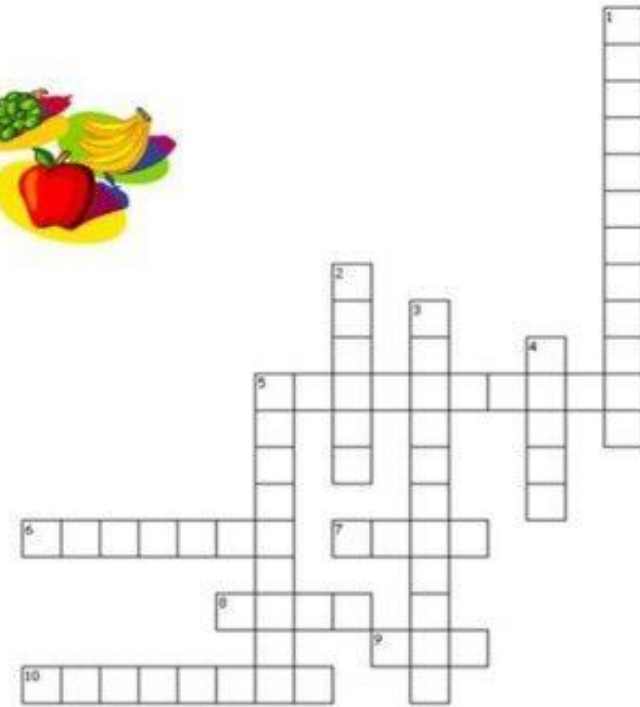
## KIDS CORNER

**On the Miracles of Jesus:** Jesus' miracles were signs of the power and presence of God's Kingdom in our midst. Just as He revealed God as Father, Creator, and Lord over creation, He revealed Himself as Son, one in being with the Father and equal to Him in lordship. Some of the miracles showed His mastery over nature, as when He walked on the water (Matthew 14:22-33) or in the miraculous catch of fish (Luke 5:1-11). In healing the paralytic (Luke 5:17-26), He revealed His power to forgive sins and to heal diseases. In healing the demoniac (Luke 8:26-39), He revealed His power over the minions of Satan. And in raising the widow of Nain's son (Luke 7:11-17) and His friend Lazarus (John 11), He revealed His power over death itself.

The miracles occurred in diverse ways. Sometimes His touch conveyed healing, as in the case of Peter's mother-in-law (Matthew 8:15). At other times, His word alone was sufficient, as when He healed the centurion's servant from afar (Matthew 8:13). Even His garment could heal, as in the case of the woman with a flow of blood (Matthew 9:20-22).

Often the healing was immediate, as with the leper in Luke 5:13. At other times it was gradual, as with the blind man at Bethsaida (Mark 8:22-25). Often the recipient's faith in Jesus was a necessary element (Luke 17:19; 18:35-43), but at other times, it was Jesus' compassion and mercy that prompted the healing, as with the bent woman (Luke 13:10-17).

Ultimately, however, the miracles were designed as revelations of who Jesus was and His inauguration of the Kingdom. *"If I do not do the works of My Father, do not believe Me; but if I do, though you do not believe Me, believe the works, that you may know and believe that the Father is in Me, and I in Him"* (John 10:37-38).
