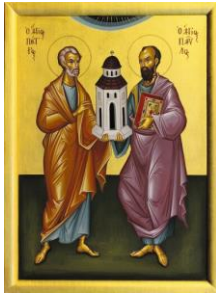


Epistle Reading

Acts of the Apostles 20:16-18, 28-36



IN THOSE DAYS, Paul had decided to sail past Ephesos, so that he might not have to spend time in Asia; for he was hastening to be at Jerusalem, if possible, on the day of Pentecost. And from Miletos he sent to Ephesos and called to him the elders of the church. And when they came to him, he said to them: "Take heed to yourselves and to all the flock, in which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers, to care for the church of God which he obtained with the blood of his own Son. I know that after my departure fierce wolves will come in among you, not sparing the flock; and from among your own selves will arise men speaking perverse things, to draw away the disciples after them. Therefore be alert, remembering that for three years I did not cease night or day to admonish every one with tears. And now I commend you to God and to the word of his grace, which is able to build you up and to give you the inheritance among all those who are sanctified. I coveted no one's silver or gold or apparel. You yourselves know that these hands ministered to my necessities, and to those who were with me. In all things I have shown you that by so toiling one must help the weak, remembering the words of the Lord Jesus, how he said, 'it is more blessed to give than to receive.'" And when he had spoken thus, he knelt down and prayed with them all.

Gospel Reading

The Gospel According to John 17:1-13



At that time, Jesus lifted up his eyes to heaven and said, "Father, the hour has come; glorify your Son that the Son may glorify you, since you have given him power over all flesh, to give eternal life to all whom you have given him. And this is eternal life, that they know you the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom you have sent. I glorified you on earth, having accomplished the work which you gave me to do; and now, Father, you glorify me in your own presence with the glory which I had with you before the world was made.

"I have manifested your name to the men whom you gave me out of the world; yours they were, and you gave them to me, and they have kept your word. Now they know that everything that you have given me is from you; for I have given them the words which you gave me, and they have received them and know in truth that I came from you; and they have believed that you did send me. I am praying for them; I am not praying for the world but for those whom you have given me, for they are mine; all mine are yours, and yours are mine, and I am glorified in them. And now I am no more in the world, but they are in the world, and I am coming to you. Holy Father, keep them in your name, which you have given me, that they may be one, even as we are one. While I was with them, I kept them in your name, which you have given me; I have guarded them, and none of them is lost but the son of perdition, that the scripture might be fulfilled. But now I am coming to you; and these things I speak in the world, that they may have my joy fulfilled in themselves."

2017 FAITH Scholarships for Academic Excellence

On behalf of *FAITH: An Endowment for Orthodoxy and Hellenism*, I'm pleased to share with you a scholarship opportunity for the graduating high school seniors.

Last month, FAITH launched its **2017 FAITH Scholarships for Academic Excellence** application. For over a decade, FAITH has awarded these merit-based scholarships to exemplary young people in the Greek Orthodox and Hellenic community who pursue academic excellence and an active involvement in their churches and communities. Awards have ranged from \$1,000 to \$20,000.

The application is available for download at thefaithendowment.org/scholarships. Completed applications must be received in the mail by the **June 30, 2017** deadline. Mailing information, full applicant criteria and complete instructions can be found at the link above.

In addition, applicants majoring in STEM fields (science, technology, engineering and math) are eligible to receive support for all four years of their undergraduate studies through the "FAITH Scholarship for Excellence in STEM." To renew the award, students must major in a STEM field, maintain a 3.6 minimum GPA and continue to actively participate in organizations related to the Greek and Hellenic Orthodox community throughout their college career.

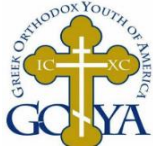

Religious Stewardship

Now, I know all of us are dying to get a piece of Anditharon in our stomachs this morning, but before that I'd like to remind all of us of where our blessed gifts have come from.

We all know that God gave us the world; he gave us the trees, the birds, the sky and everything within our visible perception. Without God, we would not have food, or homes, or even our health. But above all, God gave us opportunity. God gave us the opportunity for life, the opportunity for our sins to be forgiven, the opportunity to ascend into heaven and live among God for eternity *after* death. These gifts are great, but they mean nothing if we don't treat them right. If we don't seize the opportunities presented to us, then Jesus' sacrifice was in vain. We need to take care of God's gifts, and take advantage of the opportunities he gives us. So, if God gave us the Earth, with all its creatures, then it's our responsibility to protect the environment. We cannot throw waste in the ocean or litter in the forests, because then we are destroying God's gift. If God gives us the gift to have our sins forgiven, then it is our responsibility to attend confession and pray for mercy. God gives us the gift of eternal life in heaven, but it's our responsibility to be good people and follow His teachings.

This practice of stewardship is what God wants us to do; to be grateful for all that he gives us and to take care of it. But we must also say thank you to God. And maybe most important of all, bring your children to Sunday school, where God's gifts and His teachings will continue for generations.
