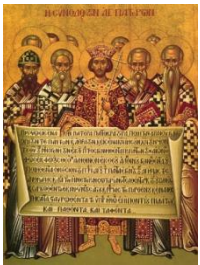


## Epistle Reading St. Paul's Letter to Titus 3:8-15

I desire you to insist on these things, so that those who have believed in God may be careful to apply themselves to good deeds; these are excellent and profitable to men. But avoid stupid controversies, genealogies, dissensions, and quarrels over the law, for they are unprofitable and futile. As for a man who is factious, after admonishing him once or twice, have nothing more to do with him, knowing that such a person is perverted and sinful; he is self-condemned. When I send Artemas or Tychicos to you, do your best to come to me at Nicopolis, for I have decided to spend the winter there. Do your best to speed Zenas the lawyer and Apollos on their way; see that they lack nothing. And let our people learn to apply themselves to good deeds, so as to help cases of urgent need, and not to be unfruitful. All who are with me send greeting to you. Greet those who love us in the faith. Grace be with you all. Amen.

The Lord said to his disciples, "You are the light of the world. A city set on a hill cannot be hid. Nor do men light a lamp and put it under a bushel, but on a stand, and it gives light to all in the house. Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father who is in heaven. Think not that I have come to abolish the law and the prophets; I have come not to abolish them but to fulfill them. For truly, I say to you, till heaven and earth pass away, not an iota, not a dot, will pass from the law until all is accomplished. Whoever then relaxes one of the least of these commandments and teaches men so, shall be called least in the kingdom of heaven; but he who does them and teaches them shall be called great in the kingdom of heaven."

### IMPORTANT MESSAGES FROM FATHER MATTHEW

1) \*\*\*As I continue to transition into my role as the canonical Head (Senior) Priest of the entire parish, I am reviewing and assessing at length the spiritual needs of the parish faithful. I ask for your prayers and your patience as I do this; such a careful and diligent **assessment** takes *time* as well as *prayer* in seeking God's will for His flock entrusted to my care. Toward the end of summer, I will inaugurate regular communication with you, the parish faithful. For I believe that the priest's relations with his parishioners must have as a starting point, the awareness of his priestly responsibility and his disposition and willingness to serve the needs of all his parish faithful everywhere and at all times.\*\*\*

2) SERVICES for the Feast of PROPHET ELIAS – which is also the parish FEASTDAY of our Prophet Elias Church – will take place at PROPHET ELIAS ONLY on Sunday, July 20, so that all our parish faithful can come together in worship and celebration. As a result, there will be NO Divine Liturgy at Holy Trinity on this day so that we may worship together at Prophet Elias only.

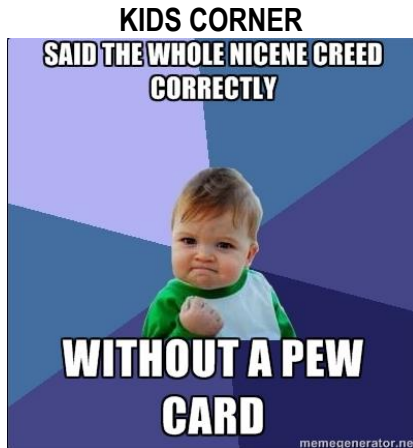
#### LITURGICAL SCHEDULE FOR THE FEAST OF PROPHET ELIAS

**Saturday evening, July 19: Great Vespers with Artoklasia, 5pm, at Prophet Elias ONLY;**

**Sunday, July 20: Feastday of Prophet Elias, Orthros and Divine Liturgy, beginning at 8:30am at Prophet Elias ONLY**

One of the many wonderful blessings that have evolved from our **Tuesday Morning Bible Study** is the implementation of our parish **Orthodox Christian Prison Ministry** program, which has been undertaken by some very dedicated and faithful Orthodox Christians. Orthodox Christian Prison Ministry (**OCPM**) is the official ministry of the Assembly of Canonical Orthodox Bishops of the United States of America, providing Holy Bibles, prayer books, publications, and icons to our Orthodox brethren in prison. On the local parish level, we are calling on all the faithful to *learn* more about prison ministry, to *pray* for people in prison, to become *involved* in prison ministry, and to *encourage* their brothers and sisters in Christ. The commitment of our local parish Prison Ministry Team is to support the work of this ministry and help to uncover the mystery of "Christ the prisoner" in our midst.

The **Feastday of Prophet Elias (Sunday, July 20)** has been designated as **Orthodox Christian Prison Ministry Sunday** at our **Prophet Elias Church**. Just as we celebrated Prison Ministry Sunday at Holy Trinity on the Feast of Pentecost last month, we are, likewise, doing the same at Prophet Elias. Thus, we are humbled to share with all parish faithful a beautifully framed icon of **Christ the Prisoner** which will be presented and displayed for veneration at the conclusion of services on Sunday, July 20. As we exit the nave of the church after services, there will be a donation basket in the narthex. We encourage everyone to make a special offering to support OCPM monetarily and to remember, as well, to pray for and rejoice with those who have found the Light of Life shining in the darkest places. Icon cards, written by Orthodox prisoners, will also be available. We invite and encourage you to become part of our local Orthodox Christian Prison Ministry program. Please speak with Father Matthew if you are interested.
