Saint Anthony, who was born in the province of Chernigov, was tonsured in the Monastery of Esphigmenou on the Hoły Mountain, Athos, from whence he was sent by his abbot to Kiev to plant the monastic life in 1013, two years before the death of Saint Vladimir, Great Prince of Kiev. Dwelling at first as a hermit, the Saint gradually drew to himself others wishing to emulate his way of life. When the number of the brethren grew, a wooden church in honour of the Dormition of the Theotokos was built, thus laying the foundation of what was to become the renowned Kiev Caves Lavra. Refusing the abbotship, Saint Anthony entrusted this to his disciples, first to the blessed Barlaam, then to Saint Theodosius (See May 3), and his whole life struggled as a cave-dwelling hermit. He reposed in peace in 1073 at the age of ninety.

For I am a man under authority, with soldiers under me; and I say to one, 'Go,' and he goes, and to another, 'Come,' and he comes, and to my slave, 'Do this,' and he does it." When Jesus heard him, he marveled, and said to those who followed him, "Truly, I say to you, not even in Israel have I found such faith. I tell you, many will come from east and west and sit at table with Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob in the kingdom of heaven, while the sons of the kingdom will be thrown into the outer darkness; there men will weep and gnash their teeth." Beloved Stewards and Friends,

I pray that my Pastoral Letter finds all of you basking in the sun's rays during these lazy summer days. Summer is a time for all of us to rejuvenate ourselves physically and spiritually in preparation for an exciting and dynamic Ecclesiastical Year ahead, starting with our Annual Greek Festival in early September.

This summer will bring some unique challenges and opportunities to our Parish with the reassignment of Fr. Patrick, who will be sorely missed, and the subsequent reality of having only one Priest meeting all of the various needs of our sizable Community. In an effort to keep everyone informed, I have deemed it beneficial to communicate with all of you at this time regarding the following items:

#### New Assistant Priest

We are doing everything we can to get a new Assistant Priest assigned to our beloved Community as soon as possible. However, the fact remains that there are around 50 parishes that need a priest and there are few clergy, if any, available at this time that would be a good match for our needs. Many parishes do not even have one priest, let alone two priests. There are also a number of parishes that are larger than ours that are in need of a second priest and have been waiting for some time. Of course, the fact that we have two Churches necessitates us having at least two priests physically present for Sundays, and I am hopeful that our special circumstance will propel us to the "top" of the waiting list. Until we get a new Assistant Priest, with Metropolitan Isaiah's blessings, Fr. Luke Kontgas has offered his assistance for most Sunday services (to keep both churches open). I ask for your collective prayers in finding the appropriate Clergyman to assist Fr. George and become a vital member of our Community Family.

#### **Scheduling Sacraments**

Effective immediately, please remember to schedule all Baptisms, Weddings and Funerals directly with Fr. George. Memorials and 40-day Churchings (babies) should be scheduled through the Church Office.

#### Clergy-Laity Congress

Fr. George, George Karahalios and Archon Nick Bapis will be representing our Parish at the Clergy-Laity Congress in NYC from July 3-8. Please pray for a successful Clergy-Laity Congress as this year's event will be celebrating the 100th Anniversary of our Greek Orthodox Archdiocese of America.



#### **Fulltime Youth Director**

In an effort to revitalize our Youth Ministry and Programs, the Parish Council, upon the request of Fr. George, has authorized the hiring of a Fulltime Youth Director. The Youth Director will work closely with Fr. George and parent Youth Advisors to ensure that our Youth Programs will be well coordinated and robust this coming Ecclesiastical Year. If you know of someone who you feel would be an excellent candidate for this position, please encourage them to apply or speak with Fr. George. As we slowly emerge from the Covid pandemic and after having a restful summer, I pray that our Youth will be back in September in full force, ready for an exciting and spiritually fulfilling year ahead!

At its most recent meeting, the Parish Council covered several items concerning the business of the parish, highlighted by the following:

- The demolition of the LaFrance cottages and apartments is well underway. We
  are targeting completion for the end of August at which time, we hope to have
  the area paved and ready for use for parishioner parking during our upcoming
  Greek Festival.
- We received a report from the Real Estate Committee regarding the ongoing negotiations for the HT campus project. Items covered included project phasing, dates for completion of the contract, parish parking, income payments during the construction, property management considerations, and reserve funding for capital improvements. The Parish Council also passed a motion requiring receipt of a negotiated contract by September 30, 2022, or the exclusivity agreement with Woodbury Corp. would expire. We are planning a special general assembly for October 9, 2022, to present the contract to the parish, with the intent of scheduling an official vote on the project at a subsequent general assembly during the last week of October. In addition, the PC intends to hold several special general assemblies during the coming year related to the project, and we very much want and need input and reaction from our parishioners. <u>Please plan to attend these very important meetings</u>.
- In the coming months, we also intend to hold a number of town hall meetings to discuss key issues facing the parish including how a quorum is defined for decision-making purposes at general assemblies.


