THE BEHEADING OF ST. JOHN





The Forerunner of Christ's presence, Saint John, lived, according to Mark the Evangelist, in the desert of Judea, proclaiming the coming of the Messiah and calling the people to repentance.

He did not hesitate to criticize the Pharisees, both for their hypocrisy and for moral wrongdoings, as well as for King Herod Antipas himself, who had an illicit relationship with Herodias, the wife of the brother, Herod Philip I.

This particular attitude of John the Baptist led first to his imprisonment and eventually to his beheading, as Salome, daughter of Herodias, had demanded: during a symposium for the king's birthday, her dancing pleased Herod so much that he promised to give her anything she desired, up to half of his kingdom.

Saint John's Honorable Head, offered to Salome on a plate, was buried in prison by the soldiers.

It should be noted that today our Church prompts the faithful to strict fasting because of the Martyrdom of John the Baptist.

The reading is from the Acts of the Apostles. (13:25-33)

n those days, as John was finishing his course, he said, "What do you suppose that I am? I am not he. No, but after me one is coming, the sandals of whose feet I am not worthy to untie." Brethren, sons of the family of Abraham, and those among you that fear God, to us has been sent the message of this salvation. For those who live in Jerusalem and their rulers, because they did not recognize him nor understand the utterances of the prophets which are read every sabbath, fulfilled these by condemning him. Though they could charge him with nothing deserving death, yet they asked Pilate to have him killed. And when they had fulfilled all that was written of him, they took him down from the tree, and laid him in a tomb. But God raised him from the dead; and for many days he appeared to those who came up with him from Galilee to Jerusalem, who are now his witnesses to the people. And we bring you the good news that what God promised to the fathers, this he has fulfilled to us their children by raising Jesus.

THE GOSPEL



The reading is from the Holy Gospel according to Mark. (6:14–30)

t that time, King Herod heard that Jesus' name had become known. Some said, "John the baptizer has been raised from the dead; that is why these powers are at work in him." But others said, "It is Elijah." And others said, "It is a prophet, like one of the prophets of old." But when Herod heard of it he said, "John, whom I beheaded, has been raised." For Herod had sent and seized John, and bound him in prison for the sake of Herodias, his brother Philip's wife; because he had married her. For John said to Herod, "It is not lawful for you to have your brother's wife." And Herodias had a grudge against him, and wanted to kill him. But she could not, for Herod feared John, knowing that he was a righteous and holy man, and kept him safe. When he heard him, he was much perplexed; and yet he heard him gladly. But an opportunity came when Herod on his birthday gave a banquet for his courtiers and officers and the leading men of Galilee. For when Herodias' daughter came in and danced, she pleased Herod and his guests; and the king said to the girl, "Ask me for whatever you wish, and I will grant it." And he vowed to her, "Whatever you ask me, I will give you, even half of my kingdom." And she went out, and said to her mother, "What shall I ask?" And she said, "The head of John the baptizer." And she came in immediately with haste to the king, and asked, saying, "I want you to give me at once the head of John the Baptist on a platter." And the king was exceedingly sorry; but because of his oaths and his guests he did not want to break his word to her. And immediately the king sent a soldier of the guard and gave orders to bring his head. He went and beheaded him in the prison, and brought his head on a platter, and gave it to the girl; and the girl gave it to her mother. When his disciples heard of it, they came and took his body, and laid it in a tomb. The apostles returned to Jesus, and told him all that they had done and taught.

Please visit the Commemorative Greek Flag on Display at our State Capitol

The Greek flag, which was presented on March 25, 2021 to the people of Utah by the Greek Orthodox Church Community of Greater Salt Lake and the Hellenic Cultural Association of Utah, is on display in the Hall of Governors at the Utah State Capitol! In a ceremony at Holy Trinity Cathedral, the flag was presented to Governor Cox, who declared that day as Greek Independence Day in Utah.

The 8' by 20' flag is showcased in a large shadow box, which also holds photos of the flag being raised at the Sacred Rock on the Acropolis, Athens, Greece, and a copy of the certification of its authenticity. The Governor authorized the flag to be on exhibit in the Hall of Governors for the remainder of the year, and he forwarded it to parishioner Stephanie Angelides, Capitol Curator for Inventory and Collections and Manager of the Capitol Preservation Board.

Stephanie prepared the placard which informs visitors of the flag's significance and the Governor's declaration. It reads, in part, as follows: "This declaration honors not only the brave freedom fighters of Greece, but also the Greek immigrants who set roots in Utah in the 1890s. . . ." Marking the bicentennial of Greece's Independence from the Ottoman Empire, the impressive flag exhibit is located at the south end of the first floor of the Capitol building. It will be on display through 2021. Everyone is invited and encouraged to visit the exhibit.
