

The Prophet Jonah, the son of Amathi, of the town of Geth-hopher (IV Kings 14:25), was of the tribe of Zabulon; he prophesied during the years 838-810 before Christ. God commanded him to go to Nineveh, the great city of the Assyrians, and to proclaim that its destruction was nigh at hand because of the sins of its people. But he, as a Prophet who knew the great compassion of God, feared that at his preaching the Ninevites would repent; that God, accepting their repentance in His love for

man, would not fulfill Jonah' threats; and that he would be branded a false prophet. So he disobeyed the divine command, and boarded a ship and departed elsewhere. Yet, the sudden and fearful sea-storm and the revelation of Jonah' disbedience caused the sailors to cast him into the sea. A great sea-monster appeared straightway by divine providence, and swallowed him up. For three days and nights he was found in its belly and he prayed, saying the words, "I cried aloud in my affliction unto the Lord my God..." (Jonah 2:3, the Sixth ode of the Holy Psalter). The sea-monster then vomited him up on dry land and he again heard God's command. Wherefore, he went and preached, saying, "In three days, Nineveh shall be destroyed." The people became terrified and all repented. The great, the small, babes at the breast, and even the irrational beasts themselves fasted, and thus, having found mercy from God, they were spared His wrath. Jonah' book of prophecy is divided into four chapters, and is placed fifth in order among the twelve minor Prophets. His three-day sojourn in the sea-monster's belly is an image of our Saviour's threeday burial and His life-bringing Resurrection (Matt. 12:39-40). His name means "dove."

Save, O Lord, Your people and bless Your inheritance, granting victory to the faithful over the enemy, and by Your Cross protecting Your commonwealth.

Apolytikion of Pentecost (for the Holy Trinity)

Blessed are You, O Christ our God, who made fishermen all-wise, sending upon them the Holy Spirit and, through them, netting the world. O Loving One, glory to You.

Apolytikion of the Prophet Elias

The incarnate Angel, the Cornerstone of the Prophets, the second Forerunner of the Coming of Christ, the glorious Elias (Elijah), who from above, sent down to Elisha the grace to dispel sickness and cleanse lepers, abounds therefore in healing for those who honor him.

You who were lifted on the cross voluntarily, O Christ our God, bestow Your tender compassions upon Your new community to which You gave Your name. Cause our faithful emperors to be glad in Your power, granting them the victories against their adversaries. But if, in our endeavor to be justified in Christ, we ourselves were found to be sinners, is Christ then an agent of sin? Certainly not! But if I build up again those things which I tore down, then I prove myself a transgressor. For I through the law died to the law, that I might live to God. I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ who lives in me; and the life I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me.

The Parish Council has had the opportunity to review the final proposed Woodbury lease along with Matt Malloy's Esq. summary and all the correspondence from the Real Estate Committee, which was distributed to the parish on May 18, 2023. The Parish Council also reviewed the Lease Committee's third-party analysis by Vic Taylor Esq. Chris Jones, Esq. York Howell and Jeff Pickett, Loan Peak financial analysis which was distributed to the parish on August 18, 2023.

On August 21, 2023, at a Parish Council meeting the members of the PC had a roll call vote to express their opinion on the proposed Lease Agreement. A "No" vote constitutes no approval and a "Yes" vote constitutes approval. The result of the PC vote is as follows:

ANNOUNCING ELECTIONS FOR THE HELLENIC CULTURAL AND ARTS SCHOOL OF GREATER SALT LAKE

Below are excerpts from the Bylaws of The Hellenic Dance and Cultural Arts School of GOCGSL, see full bylaws at <u>HERE</u>.

Mission Statement: The Hellenic Dance and Cultural Arts School of the GOCGSL is dedicated, through Orthodox Christian fellowship and committed leadership, to promoting, encouraging, and perpetuating Hellenic heritage and culture among individuals and families expressed in folk dance, art, music, and song.

Objective

- To bring together our leadership, dancers, and their families in a spirit of Orthodox Christian fellowship and love.
- To teach our participants the art and history of Hellenic folk dance and song and prepare them for opportunities to share and perform this art to our community and communities beyond.
- To teach and set by example, leadership, sportsmanship, teamwork, and the tenets of the Orthodox Christian faith to all participants.
- Our ultimate achievement to be gained is the element of sharing, teaching, and love. Never promote the idea or thought that one's good fortune is another's misfortune but strive to see that all of us grow tighter in spirit and strength. We will always seek to bring out the best of each participant in terms of ethics, morality, and character, holding high the banner of Christianity.

Positions:

1-Year Term-Beginning, October 15th, 2023-October 1st, 2024. Any steward of the Greek Orthodox Church of the Greater Salt Lake is eligible to serve. Nominations and Elections will take place and the Hellenic Cultural and Arts School Year-End Party on October 1, 2023. Absentee nominations must be made live at the meeting on October 1st, along with written acceptance of nomination from the nominee sent to hellenicdanceslc@gmail.com, prior to October 1, 2023.

<u>The President</u> will preside at all meetings and serve as official representative of the organization. He/She will serve as ex officio member of all committees. He/She will create an Agenda for the meetings and be the assigner of the bank account.

<u>The Vice President</u> will serve and aid the President. The Vice-President will preside over any meeting that the President is absent from. He/She will be a signer of the bank account.

<u>The Recording Secretary</u> will be responsible for recording and reporting the minutes for all General and Board Meetings. He/She will be a signer of the bank account.



<u>The Corresponding Secretary</u> will handle all correspondence and serve as the Public Relations officer. He/she is responsible for coordinating all performances, keeping a master calendar, and negotiating fees for all dance group performances.

The Treasurer will be responsible for paying all bills incurred by the Hellenic Dance and Cultural Arts School of the Greek Orthodox Church of the Greater Salt Lake, collect and deposit tuition and all fundraising money, and presenting financial reports at each General or Board Meetings. He/She will be responsible for collecting the expense requests from the instructors and compiles a budget to be presented for a vote at the September meeting. He/She will be a signer and keeper of all documentation related to the bank account and tuition payments.

The Costume Librarian together with the instructors shall distribute all costumes to the dancers of our school. Only the Costume Librarian shall have the authority to loan or rent Dance School Costumes to other parishes with Board approval. The Costume Librarian shall be given a key to the costume library. The Costume Librarian shall also maintain the costume library in an organized and secure manner. Costume Librarian will conduct an annual inventory and give a report to the Board by as needed.

<u>The Historian</u> will accumulate digital media for historical purposes. This is a non-voting position.
