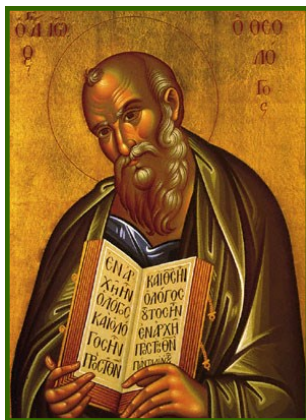

THE FALLING ASLEEP OF ST. JOHN THE EVANGELIST AND THEOLOGIAN



This Apostle was from Bethsaida of Galilee, and was the son of Zebedee and Salome, and the brother of James the elder. First a fisherman by trade, he became an Apostle and the beloved Disciple of Christ. Only he of all the Disciples followed Him even to the Cross, and was entrusted with the care of our Saviour's Mother, as it were another son to her, and a brother of Christ the Teacher. After this, he preached throughout Asia Minor, especially in Ephesus. When the second persecution against the Christians began in the year 96 during the reign of Domitian, he was taken in bonds to Rome, and there was cast into a vat filled to the brim with boiling oil. Coming forth therefrom unharmed, he was exiled to the island of Patmos, where he wrote the Book of Revelation. Returning again to Ephesus after the death of the tyrant, he wrote his Gospel (after the other Evangelists had already written theirs) and his three Catholic Epistles. In all, he lived ninety-five years and fell asleep in the Lord during the reign of Trajan in the year 100. He was called Theologian because he loftily expounded in his Gospel the theology of the inexpressible and eternal birth of the Son and Word of God the Father. It is for this cause that an eagle—a symbol of the Holy Spirit, as Saint Irenaeus says—is depicted in his icon, for this was one of the four symbolic living creatures that the Prophet Ezekiel saw (Ezek. 1:10).

Resurrectional Apolytikion

You destroyed death by Your Cross, You opened Paradise to the Robber. You turned the Myrrh-bearing Women's lament into joy, and You commanded Your Apostles to preach that You rose, O Christ God, granting the world the great mercy.

For the Theotokos

O come, all you people, and let us in faith clap our hands and sing sacred songs to her who is the Mother of God, and longingly cry aloud: "Rejoice, O protection of all those who entreat you; rejoice, the salvation of those who honor you with longing; rejoice, O Lady who restored the paralyzed man to health."

For the Holy Woman

All aflame with love for your Creator, from the teachings of the sacred preacher, you disregarded as fleeting all things mundane. And being bold in the face of the penalties, you gave yourself as a beautiful gift to God. Thecla, glorious companion of the Apostle Paul, we pray you entreat your Bridegroom, Christ, and ask Him to grant us His great mercy.

Apolytikion of Pentecost (for the Holy Trinity)

Blessed are You, O Christ our God, who made fishermen all-wise, sending upon them the Holy Spirit and, through them, netting the world. O Loving One, glory to You.

Apolytikion of the Prophet Elias

The incarnate Angel, the Cornerstone of the Prophets, the second Forerunner of the Coming of Christ, the glorious Elias (Elijah), who from above, sent down to Elisha the grace to dispel sickness and cleanse lepers, abounds therefore in healing for those who honor him.

(5:1–11)

Getting into one of the boats, which was Simon's, he asked him to put out a little from the land. And he sat down and taught the people from the boat. And when he had ceased speaking, he said to Simon, "Put out into the deep and let down your nets for a catch." And Simon answered, "Master, we toiled all night and took nothing! But at your word I will let down the nets." And when they had done this, they enclosed a great shoal of fish; and as their nets were breaking, they beckoned to their partners in the other boat to come and help them. And they came and filled both the boats, so that they began to sink. But when Simon Peter saw it, he fell down at Jesus' knees, saying, "Depart from me, for I am a sinful man, O Lord." For he was astonished, and all who were with him, at the catch of fish which they had taken; and so also were James and John, sons of Zebedee, who were partners with Simon. And Jesus said to Simon, "Do not be afraid; henceforth you will be catching men." And when they had brought their boats to land, they left everything and followed him.

Below are excerpts from the Bylaws of The Hellenic Dance and Cultural Arts School of GOCGSL, see full bylaws at [HERE](#).

Mission Statement: The Hellenic Dance and Cultural Arts School of the GOCGSL is dedicated, through Orthodox Christian fellowship and committed leadership, to promoting, encouraging, and perpetuating Hellenic heritage and culture among individuals and families expressed in folk dance, art, music, and song.

Objective

- *To bring together our leadership, dancers, and their families in a spirit of Orthodox Christian fellowship and love.*
- *To teach our participants the art and history of Hellenic folk dance and song and prepare them for opportunities to share and perform this art to our community and communities beyond.*
- *To teach and set by example, leadership, sportsmanship, teamwork, and the tenets of the Orthodox Christian faith to all participants.*
- *Our ultimate achievement to be gained is the element of sharing, teaching, and love. Never promote the idea or thought that one's good fortune is another's misfortune but strive to see that all of us grow tighter in spirit and strength. We will always seek to bring out the best of each participant in terms of ethics, morality, and character, holding high the banner of Christianity.*

Positions:

1-Year Term-Beginning, October 15th, 2023-October 1st, 2024. Any steward of the Greek Orthodox Church of the Greater Salt Lake is eligible to serve. Nominations and Elections will take place and the Hellenic Cultural and Arts School Year-End Party on October 1, 2023. Absentee nominations must be made live at the meeting on October 1st, along with written acceptance of nomination from the nominee sent to hellenicdanceslc@gmail.com, prior to October 1, 2023.

The President will preside at all meetings and serve as official representative of the organization. He/She will serve as ex officio member of all committees. He/She will create an Agenda for the meetings and be the assigner of the bank account.

The Vice President will serve and aid the President. The Vice-President will preside over any meeting that the President is absent from. He/She will be a signer of the bank account.

The Recording Secretary will be responsible for recording and reporting the minutes for all General and Board Meetings. He/She will be a signer of the bank account.





The Corresponding Secretary will handle all correspondence and serve as the Public Relations officer. He/she is responsible for coordinating all performances, keeping a master calendar, and negotiating fees for all dance group performances.

The Treasurer will be responsible for paying all bills incurred by the Hellenic Dance and Cultural Arts School of the Greek Orthodox Church of the Greater Salt Lake, collect and deposit tuition and all fundraising money, and presenting financial reports at each General or Board Meetings. He/She will be responsible for collecting the expense requests from the instructors and compiles a budget to be presented for a vote at the September meeting. He/She will be a signer and keeper of all documentation related to the bank account and tuition payments.

The Costume Librarian together with the instructors shall distribute all costumes to the dancers of our school. Only the Costume Librarian shall have the authority to loan or rent Dance School Costumes to other parishes with Board approval. The Costume Librarian shall be given a key to the costume library. The Costume Librarian shall also maintain the costume library in an organized and secure manner. Costume Librarian will conduct an annual inventory and give a report to the Board by as needed.

The Historian will accumulate digital media for historical purposes. This is a non-voting position.
