## SIX APOSTLES



On the thirty-first the six Apostles found their end.

These six holy Apostles were among the Seventy Disciples of the Lord, and were all mentioned by the Apostle Paul in his epistle to the Romans.

Stachys, whom Saint Paul calls "my beloved friend" (Rom. 16:9), was appointed the first Bishop of Byzantium, later called Constantinople, by Saint Andrew the Apostle. He built a church in Argyropolis, just outside



Byzantium, where he gathered more than two thousand Christians for instruction and the Divine Liturgy. He tended Christ's flock for sixteen years, from 38-54 A.D., and then reposed in peace.

Apelles, whom Saint Paul says that his "fidelity stood fast in the test" (Rom. 16:10), became Bishop of Heraclea in Asia Minor and, before his blessed repose, brought multitudes to the faith.

Amplias and Urban, the "beloved" of Saint Paul and his "helper in Christ" (Rom. 16:8-9), were also made bishops by Saint Andrew. Amplias was Bishop of Odyssopolis in Macedonia and Urban was Bishop of all Macedonia. For their zealous preaching of the Gospel, they suffered many torments. Amplias was put to death by pagans, while Urban was martyred by pagans and Jews.

Narcissus (Rom. 16:11) became Bishop of Athens, and after enduring torture was gloriously martyred for Christ.

Aristobulus (Rom. 16:10) became Bishop of Britain, where he preached the words of truth to the barbarians and brought many to salvation. He reposed in peace.

The incarnate Angel, the Cornerstone of the Prophets, the second Forerunner of the Coming of Christ, the glorious Elias, who from above, sent down to Elisha the grace to dispel sickness and cleanse lepers, abounds therefore in healing for those who honor him.

Kontakion 2nd Mode

O Protection of Christians that never falls, intercession with the Creator that never fails, we sinners beg you, do not ignore the voices of our prayers. O good Lady, we implore you, quickly come unto our aid, when we cry out to you with faith. Hurry to intercession, and hasten to supplication, O Theotokos who protect now and ever those who honor you.

The reading is from Paul's Second Letter to the Corinthians. (11:31-33; 12:1-9)

rethren, the God and Father of the Lord Jesus, he who is blessed for ever, knows that I do not lie. At Damascus, the governor under King Aretas guarded the city of Damascus in order to seize me, but I was let down in a basket through a window in the wall, and escaped his hands. I must boast; there is nothing to be gained by it, but I will go on to visions and revelations of the Lord. I know a man in Christ who fourteen years ago was caught up to the third heaven-whether in the body or out of the body I do not know, God knows. And I know that this man was caught up into Paradise-whether in the body or out of the body I do not know, God knows-and he heard things that cannot be told, which man may not utter. On behalf of this man I will boast, but on my own behalf I will not boast, except of my weaknesses. Though if I wish to boast, I shall not be a fool, for I shall be speaking the truth. But I refrain from it, so that no one may think more of me than he sees in me or hears from me. And to keep me from being too elated by the abundance of revelations, a thorn was given me in the flesh, a messenger of Satan, to harass me, to keep me from being too elated. Three times I besought the Lord about this, that it should leave me; but he said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness." I will all the more gladly boast of my weaknesses, that the power of Christ may rest upon me.

# THE GOSPEL



The reading is from the Holy Gospel according to Luke (16:19 - 31)

he Lord said, "There was a rich man, who was clothed in purple and fine linen and who feasted sumptuously every day. And at his gate lay a poor man named Lazaros, full of sores, who desired to be fed with what fell from the rich man's table; moreover the dogs came and licked his sores. The poor man died and was carried by the angels to Abraham's bosom. The rich man also died and was buried; and in Hades, being in torment, he lifted up his eyes, and saw Abraham far off and Lazaros in his bosom. And he called out, 'Father Abraham, have mercy upon me, and send Lazaros to dip the end of his finger in water and cool my tongue; for I am in anguish in this flame.' But Abraham said, 'Son, remember that you in your lifetime received your good things, and Lazaros in like manner evil things; but now he is comforted here, and you are in anguish. And besides all this, between us and you a great chasm has been fixed, in order that those who would pass from here to you may not be able, and none may cross from there to us.' And he said, 'Then I beg you, father, to send him to my father's house, for I have five brothers, so that he may warn them, lest they also come into this place of torment.' But Abraham said, 'They have Moses, and the prophets; let them hear them.' And he said, 'No, father Abraham; but if some one goes to them from the dead, they will repent.' He said to them, 'If they do not hear Moses and the prophets, neither will they be convinced if some one should rise from the dead ' "

Woodbury Corp. Presentation to the Parish Council and Real Estate Committee

Mr. Jeff Woodbury and his senior management team made a presentation to the Parish Council and Real Estate Committee on Monday, October 25, 2021. The presentation highlighted the process to completion, core contract terms and a financial analysis of the proposed project. Mr. Woodbury illustrated the expertise Woodbury Corp brings to our downtown development project. He reviewed similar ground lease projects Woodbury Corp has had in place for decades at Hill Air Force Base, Research Parks in Utah, Nebraska, Kentucky, South Dakota, Kansas and many other locations. The Real Estate Committee and Parish Council want to express our appreciation for the data driven presentation and look forward to further discussions on this important project for our Parish.

#### COMMUNITY PRINCIPLES AND VISION

From the beginning of this process the Real Estate Committee in conjunction with the Parish Council have been working on a potential development deal on our downtown properties with the following principles and vision in mind. These values have been generated by the community and agreed upon at previous general assemblies.

We are a Church Focus on Ministries and spreading the Gospel

We need a Community Center Our main priority is the overwhelming need to provide a new community center

**Keep our Land** - **Unsubordination** As the appropriating and decision making body, our Parish Assembly voted not to encumber our assets with any development deal. An unsubordinated ground lease enables us to accomplish this requirement.

No risk of losing our property.
Unsecured debt, if any debt is necessary

**Development Partner** Find an Institutional, Credible, Reputable, Financially secure partner with prior real estate development experience in Unsubordinated Leases
